Heath and Reach Cemetery Charges and Conditions

N.B: please see rules and regulations for detailed information

General

All Fees and payments set out below apply:

1. Where the person to be interred [or in respect of whom the Right is granted] is or was before his or her death, a parishoner of Heath and Reach [at the discretion of the Parish Council].
2. In the case of a still-born child, where the parents [or one of them] were, at the time of death, residents of Heath and Reach.
3. Where a parishoner was forced to leave the Parish for reasons of age or infirmity or other exceptional cases as agreed by the Parish Council.
4. It is not permissible to reserve burial plots by purchasing the exclusive right of burial or a burial plot for cremation, thus reserving part of the plot for future interment.

In accordance with Local Authorities Cemeteries Order 1977, in the case of re-opening of an already purchased plot and where the owner is not the person to be interred, all necessary paperwork must be in place prior to the interment date. This is also the case when applying for a monument, all paperwork must be in place prior to erection of the Monument.

CEMETERY CHARGES

Purchasing the Plot [Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial issued for a period of 75 years]

First burial of a Child under 12 years from the village	Free
First burial of a Child under 12 years from outside the village [no extra rate applies]	£50
First burial of an Adult	£200
Grant of Exclusive Rights - Cremation Plot	£75

Interment

The body of a still born child, or a child under 12 years from the village	free
The body of a child under the age of 12 years from outside the village [no extra rate applies]	£60
The body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years	£110
For the interment of cremated remains in a grave	£75

MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS, CROSSES AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

For the right to erect or place on a grave and in respect of which the Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted, but subject to the following limitations:

All burial plots:

1. TABLET STONE not exceeding 2' 6" x 2' 6" x 3"	£65
2. HEADSTONE not exceeding 2' 6" in height, 2' 3" width x 3" [overall height of 2' 9"] BASE not exceeding 2' 6" width x 12" width x 3" depth	£65
3. VASE not exceeding 18" in height	£25

4. WOODEN CROSS not exceeding 2' 9" in height	£25

All Cremation plots, in sections D, E and F of the Cemetery:

1. TABLET STONE kept level to the soil, with no fixed part rising above, and not exceeding:	
a. 12 inches x 12 inches	£25
b. 12 inches x 24 inches	£50
2. HEADSTONE not exceeding 2' height, 2' depth x 3" [not permitted in section D]	£65

ALL FEES to be increased by x5 for those living outside of Heath and Reach including monuments

Advising and drafting of Statutory Declarations **£30**

Advising and drafting of Forms of Assignment/Forms of Assent **£30**

CONDITIONS

1. All graves and plots for cremated remains should be marked with a wooden cross immediately after interment and thereafter unless replaced by a suitable monument.
2. No curbstones or edging of any type, no solid covering, chippings or gravel of any sort are allowed in any area of the Cemetery.
3. Inscriptions and tablets placed on plots for cremated remains are to be readable from the eastern side [roadside] of the plot.
6. In section D, tablet stones should be placed vertically on the grave space with the inscription for the first interment being placed at the top of the stone

Plot size to be tended:

All Burial plots in Section E and F, shall occupy a space of no more than 2.5ft width x 7ft length
All Cremation plots in Section E and F, shall occupy a space of no more than 2.5ft width x 3ft length
All Cremation plots in section D, shall occupy a space of not more than 12" width x 24" length

The foregoing table of charges, fees and conditions fixed to apply from the fifth day of March, two thousand and twelve by Heath and Reach Parish Council.
