Minutes of Meeting held on Monday 19th March at Heath Village Barn 6.30pm

1. Present: Cllrs Inns, Thyer, Green, Chivers, Fitzpatrick. Clerk in attendance
2. Apologies for Absence None
3. Declarations of Interest None
4. Review of financial records for the period 1st April 2017– 19th March 2018. These were reviewed, Clerk answered some queries and they were approved.
5. Any Other Business. The Clerk has met an architect regarding a pavilion building at Bryants Lane and Cllr Thyer has obtained some budget costs based on a preliminary design which will be in the region of £60,000. This amount would need to be achieved through grants, fund raising by the boxing club and football club and from Parish Council reserves if it is the decision of the Council to proceed. There will be a village consultation when as the plans become more developed. In the meantime, it was agreed to allocate a further £10,000 from reserves to the pavilion project should it proceed. There was a discussion about the financial priorities and it was agreed that speed cameras are the priority, but this should be discussed by the full Parish Council.
The Clerk was instructed to transfer funds from the current account to the reserve account leaving a balance of £20,000 in the current account.
Cllr Inns said she would be attending a meeting at Rushmere and would report back with their plans especially with relevance to parking situation at Thrift Road.
