Minutes of Meeting held on **Monday 2nd July** at Heath Village Barn at 6.40pm

- Present: Cllrs Fitzpatrick, Green, Owers, Clerk in attendance. Cllr Thyer late attendance
- Apologies: Cllr Malone – holiday.
- Election of Chairman: Cllr Fitzpatrick nominated by Cllr Owers, seconded by Cllr Green.
- Declaration of Interests: None.
- Review of Income and expenditure: Income to date £2,010, Expenditure £7,366. This includes £3,867 for a new fence at Thrift Road. Costs for water and electricity seem high at Bryants Lane, Clerk to arrange accurate meter readings.
- Future projects: Cllr Owers suggested a footpath at Thrift Road field to make access to the play equipment easier for prams. Cllr Thyer to investigate groundworker costs. It was agreed to take the Millennium Garden under the Sports and Recreation remit.
- AOB: Mr Ellis had reported a branch on the roof of Bryant's Lane Pavilion, Cllr Thyer has removed. Mr Ellis also dissatisfied with the maintenance of Millennium Garden, Clerk and Cllr Green have previously met with Mr Reynold of Reynolds Landscaping to discuss progress and it was agreed to continue to monitor.
- Cllr Green continues to record inspections of the paly equipment and trim trail equipment on a regular basis.
- Cllr Thyer was asked to replace 400 x 600 Keep Dogs on Leads sign at Thrift Road.
