Cllr Green noted the memorial bench by the memorial is sinking into the soft ground and offered to donate some paving slabs to sit it on.
- 7 AOB: Clerk was asked to make provision on the November agenda for Christmas gifts for the payback team. Cllr Fitzpatrick offered to supply remembrance crosses for the three war graves in the Cemetery for Remembrance Sunday, this was previously carried out by Dick Denton (RIP)
