CB/16/00232/Full Double Arches. Parish Council to request that a strict condition is imposed to ensure the caravan area remains as storage and not for residential or commercial use. [Residents' concerns received after meeting to be discussed at April PC meeting]

Parish Council comments for Mile Tree Road Appeal. Cllr Ellis report had been previously circulated and the Clerk was asked to forward to the Planning Inspectorate.
