### MINUTES

Meeting held on **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2019** at Heath and Reach Barn at 6.30pm

1. Present: Cllrs Fitzpatrick, Green, Clerk in attendance.
2. Apologies: Cllr Owers, Cllr Malone
3. Declaration of Interests: None.
4. Review of Income and expenditure: Income £8,166.47 expenditure £14,547.55. The income is over the budget of £6,400 and expenditure exceeds the £13,900 budget figure. This is mainly due to the new fence (£3867) at Thrift Road that was not included in the budget.
5. Millennium Gardens: Tony Markland has taken over the maintenance and Clerk has received positive comments on the improvements.
6. Plans for Pavilion: Cllr Thyer met a representative from the boxing club on 4<sup>th</sup> March to inspect the state of the building. There are some repairs that the boxing club will carry out themselves in order to prolong the life of the building, Cllr Thyer will investigate a leak from the roof. Clerk has spoken to Mr O'Brien who confirmed he has included the costs of a new building as a section 106 with the current planning application.
7. Review of projects: none
8. AOB: Clerk confirmed the trim trail repairs were complete with the exception of the rope which is off the guides which is not an issue and does not impact on the use or safety of the rope. **POST MEETING NOTE:** There are 17 rubber stoppers missing from the hurdles and high beam and the bolt securing the chain on one of the hurdles is missing  
Cllr Green said the fence at Woburn Road behind the goalposts has fallen down Clerk to ask Tony Markland to remove where necessary.
