3. Declarations of Interest: None
4. Review of financial records for the period 2020/21, These had been previously circulated for review. Cllr Inns asked for clarification on two payees which were confirmed by the Clerk. Covid 19 has impacted significantly on income, zero income from Bryants Lane. There are sufficient reserves, but it should be noted using these takes away from the speed camera fund. Clerk to transfer back £10,000 from the reserve account to the current account to cover outgoings. When the Covid restrictions are relaxed , hopefully by the end of July the Parish Council will start to receive a rental income from the Pavilion and in September hopefully the courts will be hired out again.
5. Review of projects: Given the current state of affairs it was agreed to put a hold on future projects. The Clock Tower will need some restoration in the near future but this can wait until there is more income from Bryants Lane. It was also agreed to hold off on the purchase of new picnic tables at Thrift Road, the badly damaged ones have been removed and the others are fit for purpose for the time being. This again will be reviewed post Covid restrictions. Clerk highlighted the CPM report on the trim trail equipment at Bryants Lane flagged as high risk. Cllr Thyer offered to inspect as the loose posts have been an issue in the past. Tony Markland to be asked to re-set with concrete
