622 622.1	<p><b>PUBLIC FORUM</b> – members of the public have a cumulative 15 minutes to address the Parish Council, no resolutions other than those on the agenda can be resolved from items raised in the public forum.</p> <p><b>Central Bedfordshire Councillor Mark Versallion Report Update</b> Cllr Versallion has an email from Bedfordshire Police, saying they had no objection to speed cameras in the village and it was up to CBC, this conflicts with the email Cllr Boyden received from the police. Clerk to send a copy to Cllr Versallion. Cllr Versallion has asked Darryl Harvey, senior to Paul Salmon, and portfolio holder, Cllr Delgado to escalate it, saying HRPC have the money and the intent and even identified the make and model of the cameras but are being passed between the Council and the police. Paul Salmon has not replied to recent emails and has not responded to telephone calls from Cllr Boyden. Mr Harvey has confirmed he will be following this up. Cllr Inns said the PC should also discuss other traffic calming measures in addition to the cameras.</p>	



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	<p>Cllr Versallion said if the situation does not progress then the local government ombudsman should be informed prior to the Press. Cllr Versallion has emails from when the raised tables were installed in the village, 7 years ago, where it was acknowledged by all involved that they were the first measure and others would follow as long money was available, the parish council has spent that time accumulating reserves for this purpose.</p> <p>Cllr Versallion reported there is a variation to the conditions of the second turbine, yet to built, to increase the size of the turbine blades. Parish Council have not yet received notification of this. Gigaclear to be reminded about the planting to the junction box at Brickhill Road.</p> <p>CBC Local plan is due to be adopted in September, Cllr Inns concerned about the absence of detail on roads and infrastructure and there does not appear to be a co-ordinated plan. Cllr Versallion periodically meets the planning officers for the new developments at Chamberlains and Clipstone, with the LTTC councillors specifically regarding highways. There is an unresolved argument between the council and AWE about the crossroads at Miletree/Vandyke/Shenley Hill Road. One proposal is that it is capped off and a new road forcing traffic to turn right to end up on Van Dyke Road, Cllr Versallion says this may encourage the new house building south of Shenley Hill Road to use SHR and through Heath and Reach. Cllr Versallion has met the Highways who are adamant this will not happen as their modelling shows that sat nav will say it is a longer route, the Parish Council are dubious of this. Cllr Versallion suggested that PC invite Dave Agar, officer from Highways to explain the plans.</p>
