MINUTES

**Meeting held on Monday 5th October 2020
Via Zoom at 6pm**

1. Present: Cllrs Fitzpatrick, Smith, Boyden, Malone, Thompson.
2. Apologies: Cllr Thyer - work.
3. Declaration of Interests: None
4. Review of Income and expenditure:
Income £2,564 actual vs £11,000 annual budget
Expenditure £16,362 actual vs £14,100 budget

Clerk noted that expenditure includes for repairs to trim trail, replacement light at the courts and works to bring donated changing rooms units up to standard. Income had been suppressed due to COVID, but Clerk reported nearly all evening slots have been taken at the court and rental income from the pavilion was now on track. Clerk has received an enquiry about hiring the car park from a film company.

Cllr Fitzpatrick asked about the electricity charge split between the courts and the pavilion building, clerk reported that a bill was due, and this would give a better indication but not a true picture as the lights will not be used at full capacity until the clocks go back.

5. Future projects:
Benches at Thrift Road will need replacing and it was agreed to wait until the Spring. Benches at Bryant's Lane were discussed but it was agreed it would not be appropriate at this stage as it may encourage people to congregate. Path at Thrift Road, quotes have been obtained, Clerk to remind Mrs Grey about looking into any grants, if none available then to ensure this is included in next year's budget.
6. AOB.
Cllr Malone asked if the PC would be willing to donate a cash sum to the village organisers of a Halloween walk. It was agreed that this should be discussed at the full PC meeting.
