



MEETING

Sports and Recreation Committee Minutes Meeting held on Monday 7th June 2021 At 7.48pm

1. Present: Cllr Fitzpatrick, Boyden, O'Brien, Bevan. Clerk, Webmaster and one member of the electorate in attendance.
2. Elect Chairman: Cllr Fitzpatrick nominated by Cllr O'Brien, seconded by Cllr Bevan.
3. Apologies: Cllr Thyer
4. Declaration of Interests: None
5. Review of Income and expenditure. Income £1,628 Expenditure £1,382. Details in May accounts. Donation from the film company will cover lost revenue from court bookings over the past 14 months. This will be shown as Bryants Lane fields income on the accounts, but the money will be in the Parish Council "pot". Bookings are quiet as usual in the Summer; it will get busy again in the winter.
6. Discuss lease agreement of Bryant's Lane playing fields. Discussed at main meeting.
7. Future projects: Clerk had circulated a quote for £937 for provision of light to the basketball court and was asked to provide an alternative quote. There was a discussion as to whether it is necessary. Clerk said the absence of a light has only been raised by a personal trainer, not resident in the village, who appears to be running his business from parish council facilities without permission or payment. A light on a PIR would encourage more night-time activity at Bryants Lane which may not be a good idea. The PC has some security in knowing who is using the courts as they are locked and secure, this would not be the case in the open basketball area.

9. AOB: Cllr Bevan said there was a lot of litter at Thrift Road, as the bins overflow and people do not think to take their rubbish home with them.
