



## MEETING

### Sports and Recreation Committee

#### Minutes of Meeting held on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September At 6.45pm at Heath Village Barn

1. Present Cllrs Bevan, Thyer (Chairman). Clerk and Webmaster in attendance
2. Apologies: Cllrs Fitzpatrick, O'Brien, Smith
3. Declaration of Interests: None
4. Review of Income and expenditure: Clerk reported income of £4346 with an outstanding invoice for electricity use of £1633 due to be paid. Expenditure £10,4246, this includes for new benches and footpath at Thrift Road.

HRC have been paying estimated bills for electricity supply at Bryants Lane, a recent meter reading generated a large bill and a proportion of this has been passed on to the pavilion user which will offset the bulk of the cost.

5. Current/Future projects

There is an issue with security at Bryant's Lane car park, two expensive padlocks have gone missing, and the gate is frequently left open Cllr. Thyer proposed installing a car park barrier with timed/coded entry to ensure the car park is kept secure. A ballpark figure for this is £3500, firm quotes to be obtained. Whilst not budgeted, the PC has received unbudgeted income from film companies which could be used to cover the cost. To be discussed at full PC meeting in October.

It has been reported that one of the tennis net and poles have been damaged beyond repair. Clerk has sourced a like for like replacement on eBay for £200, Cllr. Thyer has offered to install. It was agreed to proceed, subject to full council approval.

Cllr. Bevan asked on the status of the CPM report highlighting risks at Bryants Lane and Thrift Road. These have now been dealt with and CPM are due to inspect again in the next week or so and Clerk will circulate their report.
