- 09.22.3 PUBLIC FORUM members of the public have a cumulative 15 minutes to address the Parish Council. No resolutions other than those on the agenda can be resolved from items raised in the public forum.

4 members of the public present, 2 to talk.

5 planning applications in total were received during August with consultation dates due to expire before the next full PC meeting. Therefore, a PC Planning Committee meeting was called to discuss all 5 applications and reported back to CBC by the end of August.

MOP 1, with one of the planning applications, voiced his disappointment that the application was not heard at a full PC meeting. The applicant informed the PC that he believed the application should have been discussed at a full meeting due to the terms of reference, a new postal code was to be created. The clerk is to investigate whether this is the case and if so, discuss options with CBC before reporting back to the PC.

Number 2 parishioner spoke with his concerns against the same application.

## **09.22.5 MATTERS ARISING** (for info only):

- a) Highway speed restrictions update CBC have released 2022/2023 highways work list to include gateway & speed reduction measures on Woburn Road. The PC is very interested in any speed reductions within the village however there are no drawings to advise as to what the plans are. It is believed that the gateway work and speed restriction measures will go ahead by the end of 2023 as advised in the CBC list.
- b) **Speed Watch update:**

Cllr. Boyden reported that Speed Watch is still active with new sites being

agreed. It is having a positive impact on speeding through the village. The Speedwatch figures for July / August are 4 sessions, 890 vehicles through, 37 in excess of 35mph (highest being 48

mph)

The Chairman thanked Cllr. Boyden for his hard work on this project.

# c) Average Speed Cameras – up to date prices received. Discuss a plan for cameras linked in with CBC traffic calming:

Cllr. Thyer updated the PC with current prices for the speed cameras. Cllr. Boyden suggested, as a way forward, and without forgoing our right to have ASC's, we ask CBC to draw up and advise as to what their plans are for traffic calming. After the work has been completed and given a time scale of say, six months a traffic survey is carried out and if there is no agreed improvement within the village, we then have the right to have the ASC's. A meeting is to be requested between CBC Highways and the PC.

#### d) Carols on the Green:

Date suggested 16<sup>th</sup> December – Agreed PC to pay for sparklers as in previous years.

# e) Charity Clothes bin:

Clerk has been approached regarding housing a charity bin in the Village (possible income generator) – The PC didnt feel it was of any benefit to the Village. It was felt that It would be wrong to take money away from Charities so would be left to Villagers to donate their old clothes to which charities they wish. It was pointed out that there are clothes bins at the Tidy Tip.

#### f) Greensand Country gateway signs:

The PC have decided at this present time not to go with any new gateway signs. Due to potential new gateways in the future, it would be difficult to order the correct sign at this moment in time.
